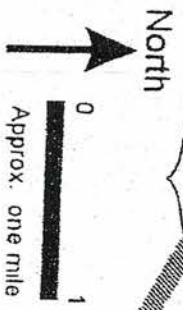
Brighton-Henrietta Town Line Rd.
